This will be good evidence to produce to the DNR in the event of trail mis-use occurs. It will be taken from Lost Lake Road to another location.
- . A resident of Pickerel Creek Road was very happy with the ATV'ers who used that road over the Memorial Day Weekend.
- . The town has extra salt/sand mix we can use to put on areas of Lost Lake and Pickerel Creek Roads.
- . Dan Wierschke encouraged some of the club members to display "Trail Patrol" signs on the front of their ATV's . When seen on trails, they do curtail unacceptable behaviors.
- . Trees were down in Augustyne Springs. Dan and Harlan Girtz removed them off the trails. There also was a report of a tree down near the Wolf River. That particular trail is not part of our trail system, therefore removal is not the responsibility of the club.
