Trail report:

- The logging on 'A' is on state land and should not affect our trails.
- Jack Andraschko, Keith Verhagen, & Dan Wierschke are checking the trails for obstructions and downed signs and will get our trails ready for the upcoming ATV season.
- With permission from a member of the Langlade Hwy Commission, the sign on "DD" saying 'Trail Ends Here' has been moved to around the corner. This will enable riders to connect DD with South Shore Drive.
- Contacts are being made with the landowners along DD to see if we can get a trail to Pickerel. Jack Andraschko has obtained permission from one landowner already.

- Town Chairman, Dick Guenther, will check the condition of Lost Lake Road to see if it is necessary to smooth out.
- A State Funded trail is in the works, and hopefully will be ready for our club to maintain and sign by the 2017 season. This trail will connect the Augustyne Ramp on Cty Hwy A to Hwy 45 then to the Railroad bed. This would allow rider's access to Antigo from the south and Summit Lake, from the north.
- Trails are scheduled to open May 1, but PLEASE check with the County Forestry Department to verify that the trails are actually ready by that date.
