Regarding the Town of Langlade: We were under the impression the ATV ordinance had passed. It has not. The White Lake Businesses want the roads open, but the board does not share their enthusiasm. Our club has concerns donating money to the White Lake Club, until the following criteria are met. We need a defined map of roads opening, number of signs needed, and what signs and posts can be obtained from the Forestry Department. Jan Fisher stated that when the Town of Hutchensen opened, each sign averaged \$22 a piece. Jack suggested that when and if the Town of Langlade opens routes, the ATV Clubs in Langlade County will get together to determine how to fund these new routes.
