- We received a call from Pickerel Point, stating their displeasure that neither the map, or our website indicates the trail to their business. We will work out a solution before the next map printing.

OLD BUSINESS:

Jack was informed by the Forestry Department that two state grants have been approved to open a trail from Cty Hwy A to Hwy 45. The \$50,000 & \$30,000 grants will incorporate a wash station, picnic area and restrooms.

NEW BUSINESS:

Our club has been approached by Gus and Diane Turk, requesting the Langlade portion of Hwy DD to be opened. They have secured signatures of all the residents who live on Hwy DD for their approval of it being an ATV route. Much discussion followed, and it was agreed that the following things have to be done:

- We need a group of citizens to get on the agenda and attend a Hwy Commission meeting
- If possible get signed letters to the Hwy Dept. from Pickerel businesses whose business would increase by opening DD.
- Another alternative may be to get permission from landowners along DD to make a trail to Pickerel. Dan, Gus and Jack will get together with a plot map to see if a trail would be feasible.

Mary Ann agreed to get \$50 gift certificates for our current land owners in appreciation of our club using their land for our trail system.

After the meeting we will leave from Hummers for our Annual Moon light and customer appreciation night ride. We will spend time at Schuh's and Final Lap before riding through the moonlit woods to Walleye Lodge for chicken.
