<p>I. Welcome & Call the Meeting to Order</p> <p>a. Roll call of officers & board members</p>	<p>a. President Vern Lee called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. and took a roll call of all officers and board members. Absent are Lisa Schultz, Emily Koszarek, Kevin Koszarek & Jack Androsko.</p>
<p>II. Meeting Minutes</p> <p>a. Reading and approval of meeting minutes from 5/18/24</p>	<p>a. Vern Lee read the meeting minutes from the previous meeting held on 5/18/24. No corrections were requested. Bob Pinno moved to accept the minutes from April 20th, 2024. Mark Starich 2nd the motion to approve.</p> <p>Next meeting will be at Norm's Hollow, 9am, July 20th</p>
<p>III. Officers Report</p> <p>a. Treasurer report</p> <p>a. Membership updates</p> <p>b. Trail conditions & concerns</p>	<p>a. Sarah Pinno presented the treasurer's report. The club received funding from Langlade County for the first round of clean-up of trails. There were about 20 more memberships added to the account this week with more trickling in. Current balance is \$49,553. If members wish to see the bank statement or reconciliations Sarah has them available anytime. Contact information is on the website. Motion to accept the Treasurer's report was Mark Starich and 2nd to accept was Diane.</p> <p>b. Monica Head presented the current membership count at 75. There are 10 businesses, 48 families, and 17 single memberships. If there is a question whether or not your dues were paid for this year, please see Monica Head after the meeting. Currently working on a QR code that will be placed on the maps. Sarah Pinno is assisting with the setup of Venmo & Paypal. This is so memberships can be processed online. Sarah is hoping to have the online form on the club website by the next meeting in July. Memberships run January through December yearly. Vern Lee asked if anyone would be interested in having a 3/ 5 year membership. One member asked about a lifetime membership. This was not thought that far ahead, said Vern Lee. Longer term memberships would eliminate a lot of paperwork. This will be on the agenda for July 2024.</p>

	<p>c. Trail Conditions by Bob Pinno. A group with Bob & Kevin Koszarek went out in Augustyn Springs to clean up branches and limbs. Some areas had downed trees and this was taken care of by other club members as well that week. Trails are in beautiful condition. The county came in and graded Augustyn Springs and the trails are smooth with some rock. Trail cleanup last week was from Norms to the trailhead.</p>
<p>IV. Unfinished Business a. Storage Shed Updates</p>	<p>a. President Vern Lee addressed the storage shed update. Dennis Giles, President, in attendance from Tombstone-Pickerel Sno Club. The county has no problems with the building. Both clubs would need to go over stipulations of maintenance and insurance. No cost to the UTV/ATV club. When the current building is complete for the snowmobile club, then both parties will meet to finalize the plans. (paperwork for the county and an agreement with the snowmobile club) Electricity and water will be available for the shed. Dennis commented that the landowners are a priority when clubs come together to plan these ideas. Vern Lee stated that the size of the shed is still under discussion. Bob Pinno suggested 14x30 because going too small would not be good practice if more storage was required in the future. Price difference would not be a significant margin.</p>

This takes place on June 29th. There will be 2 tour guides in the morning and in the afternoon taking place. Suggested ride through Augustyn Springs from their trail system. The snowmobile club challenged our club to match their donation of \$1,000. Through emails and texts it was approved to donate that money to her. Looking at rectifying the situation in the next couple of weeks.</p> <p>Club member Patty asked about any consideration of another UTV/ATV raffle for next year. Vern Lee said “yes”, with funds needing to be specified where they are going. Will look at next year funding the shed being built. Suggestions are a cash raffle because having another UTV raffle has more factors than an upfront cash raffle. Still ongoing discussion.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a.
